BYLAW NO. 3\99

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin No. 190 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw the expresssion:
 - a) " public highway " shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highways and Transportation Act but shall not include a Provinicial Highway as designated pursuant to such act:
 - b) " motor vehichle " shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highway Traffic Act.
- 2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 30 kilometres per hour on a public highway with the Hamlet of Highwood Beach.
- 3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected on all streets entering the Hamlet and shall be placed at the point of entry or commencement of the speed zone.
- 4. Any person guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
