A Bylaw to Provide for the Enforcement of the Bylaws of the Municipality pursuant to Section 381 of The Municipalities Act

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUFFERIN NO. 190

BYLAW NO. 07-2023

TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR THE CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin No. 190 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".
- 2. "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Dufferin No. 190.
- 3. Section 5 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a Bylaw of the Municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
- 4. No person shall provide a false or misleading statement to any Bylaw Enforcement Officer, Designated Officer, Peace Officer or person appointed to enforce any Bylaw of the Municipality.
- 5. Every person who contravenes any provision of any Bylaw of the Municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - a. In the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues; and
 - b. In the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.
- 6. Bylaw No. 04-2004 is hereby repealed.
