
# Frequently Asked Question: Where do my Tax Dollars go?

#### **Control Burning**

<u>Reminder to all RM Rate payers</u>: Always report your planned control burn to avoid possible fire call costs. When burning grass, bush piles, stubble, etc. please be sure you are well-prepared and that you have fire guards in place. The Control Burn Centre number is: 1-866-404-4911.

<u>Fire Insurance Coverage:</u> Ratepayers are responsible for any firefighting charges when the Fire Department is called for a fire on your property, whether your parcel is occupied or vacant. Please be sure to have adequate Fire Insurance coverage for your property.

<u>For the information to land owners</u>: If anyone would like to withdraw their land from SMHI it can only be done for the total insured cultivated land. Partial withdrawal of lands are not permitted. To do so, please fill a withdrawal application form on or before March 31<sup>st</sup>.
